**PROOF OF AGE** – your 3i-D Card displays the PASS hologram, endorsed by the Home Office.

**TRAVEL** – pay the fares you're entitled to for your age on buses in East Sussex PLUS additional fare discounts – visit www.3i-d.co.uk

#### THE PHOTO SUPPLIED FOR THE APPLICATION SHOULD:

- be taken against a single colour background
- be in colour, not black and white
- be clear and in sharp focus, with a clear difference
- between the face and the background
- be of the holder facing forward and looking straight at the camera
- be taken with nothing covering or obscuring the face

# How long will my card be valid?

The **11 to 16** year card is FREE and is available when you turn 11 and will be valid up until the 31 August following your 16th birthday.

The **16 to 19** card is FREE and is available when you turn 16 and will be valid up until the 31 August following your 19th birthday.

### How and where to send your application

We use registered establishments to authorise 3i-D applications for example schools/colleges and East Sussex libraries. For details of all registered establishments visit www.3i-d.co.uk.

Once a registered establishment has authorised your age and identify they will send your form off to be processed. It will take up to 28 days to arrive directly to your home address.

### Applying for a 3i-D - what you need to know

- You must be training, working, studying or living in East Sussex for at least one year.
- Complete the 3i-D card application form overleaf and take the form, photo and proof to a registered establishment.
- Applications can take up to 28 days to process and the 3i-D card will be sent directly to your home address.
- All personal data supplied in your application form remains confidential and is never passed on to third parties.
